

Personal Protective Equipment Policy

SEPCO Oil and Gas Industry is committed to the use of Personal Protective Equipment and the correct use of appropriate PPE within all SEPCO's workplace areas. This PPE Policy applies to all personnel working in Mauritania and is also applicable to other company or contractor group personnel entering workplaces.

Standards

PPE is required for all in order to meet best practices and recognized international Safety Standards.

PPE Availability

Personnel wishing to enter a workplace area and who do not have the appropriate PPE are required to contact the site supervisor at workplace for the appropriate PPE to be issued. All personnel entering into a work area and intending to either work in, or transit in the area are required to have the following approved PPE:

- Safety Boots / Shoes;
- Long Sleeve Shirt;
- Long Trousers;
- Safety Glasses;
- Safety Helmet;
- Work gloves (where appropriate).

Nominated Work Areas

- SEPCO oil and Gas Industry Supply base/ Warehouse / Waste Yard

Personnel remaining in vehicles in these areas are not required to have any specified PPE, however personnel visiting these areas must be aware of the need to set and maintain a good PPE example to those working in the area.
