

Security Policy

SEPCO Oil and Gas Industry is a safety conscious and responsible company that is committed to operate in a manner which will ensure the highest standards of safety and security protection for its personnel and assets is maintained.

The intent of this policy is to provide guidance in the protection of SEPCO against security impacts to personnel, acts of terrorism, unauthorised access to data, sabotage or wilful damage to plant and/or equipment, theft of material or disruption of services or operations due to security breaches.

The level of protection will correspond to the assessed level of risk and will, where necessary, incorporate the following measures:

- Personnel security;
- Physical assets security;
- Communications security;
- Computer, data and information security.

Security decisions will be provided the same level of importance as other administrative decisions and will be formulated on a sound factual, financial, lawful and ethical basis. Staff and Line Managers are responsible for implementing and managing effective security arrangements within their areas of operations and are responsible for creating and maintaining appropriate security environments based on the relevant assessment of risk.
